HOLY THURSDAY: EVENING MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

On Thursday night Lent has ended and the Church, at this Mass of the Lord's Supper, enters into the Easter Triduum. From the very first moment the all-embracing experience of these three days is proclaimed: "We should glory in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, for he is our salvation, our life, and our resurrection. Through him we are saved and made free." This is the whole of the great Triduum. On Thursday night, the liturgy draws us toward this through the scriptures, through the mandatum or washing of the feet, which is the direct expression of our service to one another and the world, through the Eucharistic banquet itself.
